

# START HERE FOR IOS APP



**IMPORTANT:** Use only the power supply provided.

#### **ITEMS NEEDED:**

- 1. Pro Ex 2.0 WiFi Enabled Irrigation Controller
- 2. RF Module
- 3. WiFi Hub

## **Powering and Placing your WiFi Hub:**

A) Pick a dry location inside the home or in the garage with good WiFi signal strength. An easy way to evaluate signal strength is using the WiFi signal indicator on your smartphone or tablet; the icon should be full. \*\*Do not place hub next to large metal appliances, e.g. hot water heater, air conditioning unit, etc.



**B)** After plugging the power to the WiFi Hub, the "K" LED light should be flashing (On/ Off). This may take several seconds.



**NOTE:** If the LED is not flashing, reset the hub using the setting button located on the bottom base of the unit. The "K" LED should start flashing (On / Off) after holding down the button for three seconds.



# Creating a User Account and Connecting the Wifi Hub to the Controller for the first time using an iOS Device:

#### STEP 1


Download the K-Rain Pro EX WiFi App From the itunes App Store.





#### STEP 2

Click on "Create Account" Button



#### STEP 3

Enter a valid e-mail address



#### **NOTE**:

Password must be at least 6 characters long.

#### STEP 4

Enter user information

**NOTE:** Smartphone or tablet MUST be connected to the WiFi network in order to connect the WiFi Hub.



#### STEP 5

Reminder screen. After following procedure indicated, click Next.



#### STEP 6

Click "Open Settings" button and go to the general WiFi settings on the iOS settings screen.





NOTE: For dual-band routers, make sure your smartphone/ tablet is connected to a 2.4GHz WiFi Network. This device is not compatible with 5GHz WiFi signals.

# Connecting your phone to the WiFi Hub:

#### STEP 7

Select the KRAIN WiFi network.
The WiFi Hub creates a momentary
WiFi network during this process
in order to pair with your router.
(During this time the "K" LED is flashing).

# Connecting your controller to the WiFI Hub:

#### STEP 8


Go to the Pro Ex 2.0 controller faceplate. Move the dial to the REMOTE/PIN location.



Press UP button until you see NO WiFi on controller LCD.

Press MANUAL START/NEXT button and it will start searching for the WiFi Hub.

When the display shows "YS WiFi" on the LCD, it has been paired with the WiFi Hub.



FINDING

#### STEP 9

Go back to K-Rain Pro EX 2.0 WiFi
Controller App. It will show this screen
as a reminder that the Controller and
WiFi hub had to be paired before
going into the next step.



## **Connecting your WiFi Hub to your Router:**

#### **STEP 10**

Enter home network WiFi Network (SSID) and password. Click configure controller.



#### STEP 11

Confirmation Screen. Wait a few minutes for the WiFi Hub to connect to the Cloud.

At this point, the blue light on Hub should stop flashing and become solid. If blue light is not solid, has gone out or still flashing, click "Try Again", follow instructions.

**NOTE**: It is important to completely fill in address for Weather Forecast and **Weather IQ™** accuracy.



# **Powering and Placing your WiFi Hub:**


A) Pick a dry location inside the home or in the garage with good WiFi signal strength. An easy way to evaluate signal strength is using the WiFi signal indicator on your smartphone or tablet; the icon should be full. \*\*Do not place hub next to large metal appliances, e.g. hot water heater, air conditioning unit, etc.



**B)** After plugging the power to the WiFi Hub, the "K" LED light should be flashing (On/ Off). This may take several seconds.

# Creating a User Account and Connecting the Wifi Hub to the Controller for the first time using an Android Device:

#### STEP 1

Download the K-Rain Pro EX WiFi App From the Google Play App Store.





**NOTE:** From the Settings Menu on your device, grant "all permissions" after downloading app.

#### STEP 2

Click on "Create" Button



**NOTE:** Password must be at least 6 characters long.

#### STEP 4

Enter user information **NOTE:** Smartphone or tablet MUST
be connected to the WiFi network
in order to connect the WiFi Hub.




#### STEP 3

Enter a valid e-mail address



#### STEP 5

Reminder screen. Enter user information. After following the procedure indicated, click Next.





**NOTE:** For dual-band routers, make sure your smartphone/tablet is connected to a 2.4GHz WiFi Network. This device is not compatible with 5GHz WiFi signals.

## **Connecting your controller** to the WiFl Hub:

#### STEP 6

Go to the Pro Ex 2.0 controller faceplate. Move the dial to the REMOTE/PIN location.

Press UP button until you see NO WiFi on controller LCD.

Press MANUAL START/NEXT button and it will start searching for the WiFi Hub.

# **Connecting your WiFi Hub to vour Router:**

#### STEP 8

Enter your home network WiFi Network (SSID) and password. Click configure controller.



#### STEP 9

Confirmation Screen. Wait a few minutes for the WiFi Hub to connect to the Cloud. At this point, the blue light on Hub should stop flashing and become solid. If blue light is not solid, has gone out or still flashing, click "Try Again", follow instructions.

Name your controller, complete address location of this controller. Click next.



# Adding a Pro Ex 2.0 WiFi Controller to Your Account

Register for a professional account at: www.krain.com/proexcontractor

**NOTE**: The homeowner must enable the share feature via their account prior to adding a controller to the contractor's account.

Ask the homeowner to complete the contractor information card included for you.

#### **WEBSITE METHOD:**

To add a controller via web browser (MAC address):
Go to myproex.krain.com and login. Select "My Account" page. Enter MAC Address printed on WiFi Hub and Click ADD. Refresh Screen.

The controller should now appear. MANAGE allows you to log into that controller and modify settings.




If controller does not appear, contact the homeowner and ask them to share via the instructions provided.

## FROM NATIVE IOS/ANDROID App:

You should receive an email from the homeowner with an attachment. If you have the App installed, simply tap on the attachment to install:

# Sharing Your Pro Ex 2.0 WiFi Controller

## FROM NATIVE IOS/ANDROID App:

Download the K-Rain Pro EX WiFi App from the itunes or Google Play App Store.

Complete the homeowner and contractor information cards included and give the card to your contractor.

#### **Email share method:**

If you have email set up on your smart phone, you can share your controller by tapping "Share" in the App on the Account Page.

Tap "Share Controller" and enter contractor's email address from the completed information card. Tap "Share" underneath the email address field.





The App will generate a share file in an email and send it directly to the contractor.

#### **WEBSITE METHOD:**

Go to **myproex.krain.com** and log into your account. In the "My Account" page. Click "Share" next to your controller and then save. The contractor will then be able to add your irrigation controller to their account based on the information documented (MAC Address) during controller installation.
